This will be open to different age groups, including Key Stage One, at varying times of the year.</p>	<p>Ongoing</p>
<p><i>We will pay for a popular extra-curricular girl's football club which allows a girls team to be entered into the GPSFA League.</i></p>	<p>£400 (Based on 33 1 hr sessions)</p>	<p>Higher participation levels for girls and as a school we will be able to cater for the very high demand for an after school girls' football club.</p>	<p>Ongoing</p>
<p><i>We will pay for or heavily subsidise the cost of transporting children to sporting events and activities</i></p>	<p>£900 (Based on 6 events at an average cost of £150 per event)</p>	<p>Parents and Carers will not be discouraged from allowing their children to participate in off-site sporting activities because of difficulties around safely transporting their child to events and activities, thus increasing participation levels especially from our "disadvantaged" children</p>	<p>Ongoing</p>
<p><i>Following a comprehensive audit, we will purchase new PE resources and equipment, such as balls, rackets, and skipping ropes, as well as specialist equipment to enable us to focus on particular areas of the curriculum and certain team sports.</i></p>	<p>£1600</p>	<p>This will improve PE teaching and provide better learning opportunities because the children will be using good quality equipment, which is in good condition and appropriate for their age</p> <p>We will have all the necessary equipment to compete in inter-school tournaments and leagues, such as Kwik- Cricket and Rounders.</p>	<p>Ongoing</p>

<p><i>We will purchase a new PE shed for storing equipment</i></p>	<p>£2000</p>	<p>The existing PE resource shed is old and becoming rotten, resulting in equipment being damp, damaged and inaccessible. New accommodation will mean that equipment can be stored securely and kept dry, thus encouraging increased use and participation in PE and sport.</p>	<p>Ongoing</p>
<p><i>We will continue to be affiliated to the GPSFA, so we can enter the Football, Netball, Tag-Rugby and Cricket leagues. We will also enter specific GSSN, when schools can pay a one off entry fee.</i></p>	<p>£1000</p>	<p>This will facilitate our pupils' participation in competitive sport with other schools, which will in turn raise the profile of sport in school.</p>	<p>Ongoing</p>
