Inviting dads and male role models of our Year 3 and 4 students to come into school and join their children for sports activities each week. We have been lucky enough to engage dads, stepdads, cousins and a grandad to our group. During the 8 weeks, so far, we have created a crazy golf course, had football training from Hartpury College students, played dodgeball, cricket and tennis.
