





Why is it sometimes called **Free School** Meals?

What is the Pupil **Premium Grant?**

It is a sum of money that is paid directly to schools. We use it in lots of different ways to support children with their learning and to provide them with interesting and exciting opportunities.

Children who are eligible for **Pupil Premium** Funding often receive Free School Meals.

If a child stops being eligible for Free School Meals, the school continues to receive the additional funding for six years after the initial application. This is called Ever 6

Your child may receive Pupil **Premium Funding** if you receive:

Income Support

JSA

ESA

Child Tax Credit

Working Tax Credit run-on

Universal Credit

Support under Part 4 of the **Immigration and** Asylum Act 1999. If a child is in care. has been adopted from care, or has left care, we receive an increased sum of money to support them

If either parent works in the Services, the small receives a small amount to support the child's specific needs.

How will it help my child in school?

We spend some of the money on training, to continue to improve teaching and learning.

We also use the money to...

Provide targeted support for individual children:

Enable all children to take part in school trips;

Fund extracurricular clubs How else may it help my child?

From September 2022, all children who are in receipt of Pupil Premium Funding will be able to receive a free school jumper.

How do I apply?

All you need are a few personal details, your email address, and your National Insurance Number.

It's a very easy process and will only take a few minutes.

You will find out instantly whether or not your child is entitled to Pupil Premium Funding.

Parents of children in all year groups still need to apply, even if they are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2.
