Dear Parents and Carers,

My first week at Beech Green has been a flavour of what happens in our school, I have:

- spoken to almost all of the classes in the school to gather the thoughts and ideas of the children and answered their questions. The children have lots of ideas about what would make our school even better and there have been some really thoughtful questions. Thank you everyone;
- attended a Year 2 IMPACT meeting about reading, all the parents and carers said it was extremely useful;
- met with people who are considering Beech Green Reception class and found out about our excellent Foundation Stage thanks to Miss Whitfield's presentation;
- worked with almost all the staff to review the school development plan and our school values;

- celebrated good and excellent attendance in assembly.

Throughout the five days, I have been impressed. The children in Beech Green smile and say 'hello' to me on the gate morning and evening, they hold doors open for each other, say please and thank you to adults and children and they are enthusiastic about their work. Most of them seem happy to be here most of the time. This is not an accident, it is simply because you have instilled a sense of personal responsibility and taught them to be thoughtful and polite. This means that your children are a delight to teach, thank you!

The staff are proud of our school and rightly so. They demonstrate genuine determination to support every child as an individual. The adults here really care about the children, their emotional and educational development. Everyone works hard and does a little bit more than expected, which lightens the load for us all and means the Beech Green ship sails smoothly, most of the time.

However, we all get things wrong: it is part of being human. Children, staff, parents, carers and especially headteachers make mistakes. I have already forgotten to announce the attendance shield winners, set off the school alarm and nearly locked Mr Morris out! I would encourage you all to contact us as soon as you feel things are not going well at school or at home. One of our top priorities this year is to further develop a partnership with you and have honest, calm conversations about your child, for the good of your child's school experience.
