




Recognising Respect



On Monday each class presented their values award work to the whole school. This opportunity to share information and activities linked to our school values gave individual and groups of children the chance to speak up and celebrate what they have done well.

Every pupil and adult watched and listened as the year group spoke about their work:

Reception children have been learning hoe to sign please, thank you and you're welcome so they can be polite to everyone in silence (a very useful skill).

Year 1 and 2 have given out over 400 RESPECT stickers; they have worked out that this needs to be handed over to the Year 6 Play Makers in September


Year 3 invited the Play Team to have tea and cake with them; they used the opportunity to find out more about what lunchtimes are like for the adults. The children have created their own Respect Rap.

Year 4 have made the important link between reaction and respect. They explained that feeling angry or upset can make you behave in a disrespectful way. Knowing more about how to manage big emotions can help.

Year 5 also found out about our play team; so many interesting facts! Your children might be able to tell you what they found out.

Year 6 spent time finding out about what respect looks like at Beech Green. They worked together to create films to illustrate how behaviour has a huge impact on others.

The Holiday Activity and Food Programme

What is it?

HAF is for those receiving benefits related free school meals.

HAP is for those that don't, but who would still benefit from taking part in activities.

The Holiday Activity and Food (HAF) programme is funded by the Department of Education, with strict guidelines on eligibility. HAF can only be offered to those in reception to year 11 who receive benefits-related free school meals.

The programme offers a range of activities for children and their families including family play days, football camps, music workshops, arts and craft and more and many of these activities provide food.

We understand that all children and young people can benefit from a programme like HAF, which is why Gloucestershire County Council have been working hard to secure extra funding to extend the offer to all families. This means we are now able to offer this programme to other children – HAP.

When is it?

The summer HAF programme will be running from 24th July – 1st September.

How can I get it?

What is available?

There will be a variety of face-to-face activities, fitness & sports clubs, music opportunities and much more.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Beech Green Primary School has expressed an interest in offering individual & small group tuition through Gloucestershire Music (GM) for the following instruments.

Violin Ukulele

Instrumental lessons are a great way to not only engage your child in music making but are also proven to improve their confidence, concentration and much research has shown the positive effect of music on English and Maths in particular. The time that lessons commence will be decided in due course by your school and the GM tutor who will deliver the lessons. GM staff are DBS checked, and are quality assessed to maintain the highest standards of teaching across the county. **There may be additional instrumental options privately organised by your child's school.**

Should your child require an instrument they can be hired form GM. Information on prices for this scheme can be found at www.gloucestershiremusic.co.uk (about:blank)

A student bursary is also available for those who wish to apply for financial assistance. This can cover tuition, instrument hire and exam fees up to £200 per term (based on a 3 term year). If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium and you are unable to receive a bursary or need more financial assistance, please contact the school to discuss how they might be able to help.

- 2) Under the School Direct Tuition section select your child's school from the list.
- 3) Select the relevant instrument lesson from the available options.
- 4) Complete the details over the next pages.
- 5) Once you have completed this and created your Schooble account, complete your application.
- 6) Once we have organised the tutor, you will receive an email offering you a place in that music lesson.
- 7) Follow the instructions to accept the place and make your payment.
- 8) Once we have received the payment, lessons can begin.
