Congratulations to Elm, Ash and Pine who all achieved first place in their Sport's Day. The Year 5 and 6 pupils in Pine will have an opportunity to run a lap of honour later this term. Overall congratulations to Elm! Your non-school uniform day will be on Friday 5th July.

Year 4 and Year 6 teachers will send a Parent Mail about non-uniform days as both year groups were awarded Platinum for their values project work. Year 4 collected and delivered over 500 items to the Community Pantry; Year 6 have secured funding for dual language books and will help make an entrance display. Year 6 have learned about bilingualism, did you know there are eighteen different languages spoken by pupils at home? All the work on diversity and heritage has helped us consider what would be useful to know about each individual child. 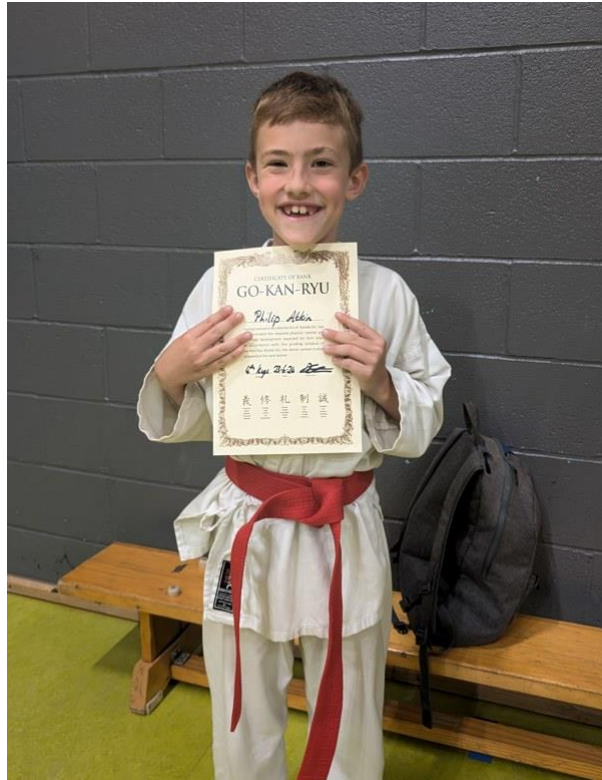
