#### **Reminders:**

- **Uniform**: Please ensure your child is in the correct uniform each day. You can find uniform guidelines on the website.
- **Punctuality**: The doors open at 8:45am. Please ensure your child arrives on time so they can start their day settled and ready to learn.
- **Healthy Lunches**: We encourage healthy eating habits. Please provide your child with a nutritious lunch and snacks.
- **Parking**: Parents and carers must not park in the school staff carpark unless they have been given permission from the school office e.g. for a limited time due to medical reasons. To keep children as safe as possible, please make sure you use the path; you can still enter through the carpark gate, which will be pulled half way to prevent cars swinging in.

- **Bikes and Scooters**: children must wear a helmet and step off their bike before entering the school gate. Staff will be reminding pupils before and after school.
- Home Reading: In the next few days your child will bring home their new reading record and a reading book. We can not stress enough the importance of reading. Please ensure you hear your child read a minimum of three times a week and it would be beneficial if you could discuss together what you've read. Please record all reads in the reading record. If you'd like anymore guidance with this, feel free to contact your child's class teacher






#### Rainy days ahead

In anticipation of the winter months, please make sure your child has a pair of wellies and a pair of old trainers in school for wet playtimes. Children also need a waterproof coat. Please remember to clearly label all items coming into school.



The start of a new academic year is a great time to begin Rocksteady lessons. Your child can enjoy the magic of music by learning to play in their very own band through weekly in-school rock and pop lessons. It's the perfect chance to learn new musical skills while having fun. Parents often find that Rocksteady lessons also boost children's self-belief, wellbeling, life skills and even academic achievement.

Your child will progress through the Rocksteady curriculum and collect up to 300 different musicianship, performance and instrument skills along the way.

Gloucestershire County Council is committed to supporting families with 1 week of vouchers at £15 per child, per week for the October 2024 half-term.

This is funded through grant funding we have received, and is separate to that of term time free school meals and the HAF programme. The offer complements the Holiday Activity and Food programme (HAF) taking place through the longer holidays which can provide a meal for children attending events. Vouchers are not available as an alternative to HAF.

The Holiday Free School Meals Voucher scheme is for eligible children in reception to year 11 who receive Pupil Premium free school meals. We are unable to consider college and sixth form students, or children who receive infant free school meals (available to all children in reception to year 2) as they are not eligible for this scheme.

Families who have signed up previously do not need to re-register for October 2024 half-term holiday vouchers - they will already have been included. To ensure we reach all those who are eligible, we are encouraging parents that have not previously signed up, to sign up as soon as they can. Applications for Holiday Free School Meal vouchers for the October 2024 half-term holiday are open from midday on 2 September 2024 until midday on 20 September 2024. Voucher emails will be sent out week commencing 30 September 2024. Please check your junk/spam email folders during this period as sometimes the vouchers end up there.
